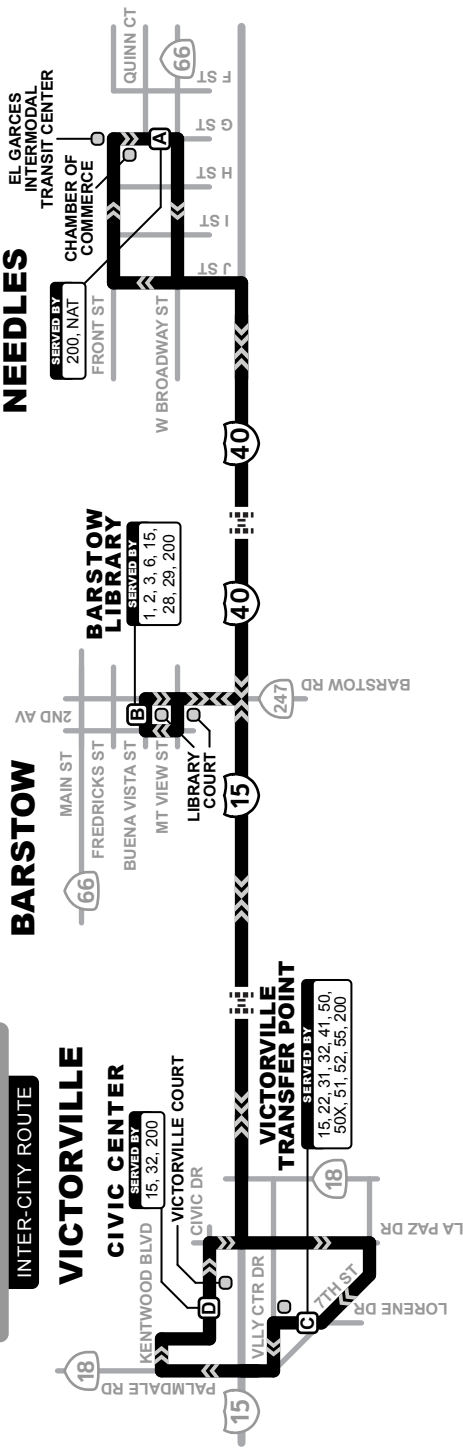

VETERAN: Military veteran identification required. **CHILDREN:** Children 5 & Under (3 children maximum per adult fare; additional children must pay adult fare).

VVTA Route 200 Needles Link seating is limited. Reservations are recommended and may be scheduled from two weeks in advance to the day prior to service before 5 p.m. Needles residents may reserve curbside pick up and drop off service. A Ludlow restroom stop is available by request only. Needles Link fare media may be used as fare on VVTA and Barstow Fixed Route and County Route buses on the same day of purchase at no additional charge. Connecting service to San Bernardino is available via VVTA Route 15 B-V Link at Victorville Transfer Point for an additional fare. Carry-ons are limited to two packages. Dimensions are limited to 22 X 9 X 14 inches and must remain in passenger lap or under seat.

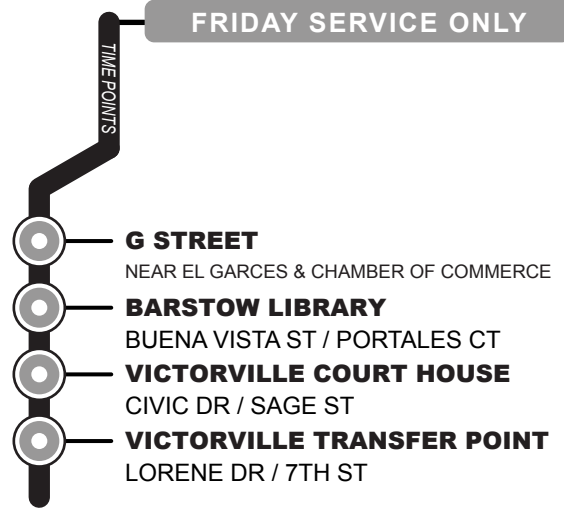
SDM: Senior / Disabled / Medicare / Medicare: All require identification. Seniors 60 and over. **VETERAN:** Military veteran identification required. **CHILDREN:** Children 5 & Under (3 children maximum per adult fare; additional children must pay adult fare).

VVTA Route 15 B-V Link features one-way fare charged per segment with two available segments: Barstow to Victor Valley, and Victor Valley to San Bernardino Valley. B-V Link fare media may be used as fare for one segment trip on B-V Link and on VVTA Fixed Route and County Route buses within six hours of purchase at no additional charge. Passengers with VVTA Route 15 fare media, including mobile, is good for one free boarding on Omnitrans or MARTA. Passengers with valid Omnitrans and MARTA fare media receive a \$1.00 discount when paying B-V Link fare from stops departing San Bernardino Valley on the same day of travel. Carry-ons are limited to two packages. Dimensions are limited to 22 X 9 X 14 inches and must remain in passenger lap or under seat.

PASSENGER GUIDELINES

Victor Valley Routes operate weekdays 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., Saturdays 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., Sundays 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. • Barstow Routes buses operate weekdays 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., weekends 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. • No service is provided on following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day • Fare must be ready and is due upon boarding • Drivers do not make change • Pennies not accepted • Fare good for single direction trip only • **Discount & Student Passes require presentation of photo I.D. when boarding; no refunds or replacements if passes are lost, stolen, damaged, or unused; passes are not transferable and only valid to person originally issued; use by others is fare evasion, resulting in confiscation, possible prosecution, and fines** • Arrive at bus stop 5 minutes prior to scheduled departure • For safety reasons, do not change seats while bus is in motion • Only bus related questions to the driver are permitted...not conversations. • Operator reserves right to refuse service to persons who are intoxicated, abusive, offensive to others, or not properly clothed • No smoking or eating on bus • Drugs, weapons, and recyclables are prohibited • Only non-alcoholic drinks are allowed in solid containers with resealable lids • Soliciting or distributing literature in buses is prohibited • Carry-ons are limited to two packages on Route 15 B-V Link and six packages on all other routes; dimensions limited to 22 inches X 9 inches X 14 inches; must remain in passenger lap or under seat; this may include a pet carrier; larger items not permitted • Service animals are permitted • Small pets in a pet carrier are permitted • VVTA not responsible for lost or stolen items • In the event of an emergency, buses will return to nearest safe layover zone to await further instructions • Service inquiries may be directed to (760) 948-3030.

PASSENGER DESCRIPTIONS

CHILDREN: 5 & under (3 children maximum per adult fare; for each additional child, student fare must be paid, if available; otherwise, adult fare must be paid). **SENIOR / DISABLED / MEDICARE (SDM):** All require photo ID. Seniors are 60 and over. **STUDENT:** Age 6-13. Age 14 and over require student photo ID. **VETERAN:** Military veteran photo ID required. **31-DAY PASS:** The 31-Day Pass is acceptable as fare for 31 days, beginning the first day it is used in farebox.

VVC STUDENTS

VVTA accepts valid Victor Valley College (VVC) Associated Student Body (ASB) or VVC Photo ID cards as fare on all VVTA Fixed and County Route buses. VVC ID cards are valid as fare during the term (or semester) for which they were issued, which spans from the official term start date through the first week of the next term. Cards issued for the previous term are not valid as fare, unless a valid decal from the current term is attached. **The VVTA Student ID does not and will not replace the VVC ID cards.** The VVTA Student Photo ID is a discount fare identification card available to verified students throughout VVTA's service area. **The VVTA Student Photo ID does not replace the VVC ASB or Photo ID pass cards, which is exclusive to VVC students.**

COUNTY ROUTES

County Routes serve the unincorporated San Bernardino County area and require County Route Fare for passengers boarding and/or alighting in the county area. Passengers may flag down the bus to stop along designated route in unincorporated county area where safe. Route Deviation service is available within 3/4 of a mile of the unincorporated county area of the route.

ROUTE DEVIATION

Route Deviation is available within 3/4 of a mile of the route. Route Deviation Fare is required. Certified ADA passengers may make reservations according to their certification. Pickup and drop off is available where safe. Drop off requests must be made to driver. On Victor Valley area routes, pickup and drop off is not available on dirt roads. On Barstow area routes, pickup and drop off is available on county-maintained dirt roads, pending road conditions. Pickups are available by reservation only. Reservations must be made at least two hours in advance and made no more than the day prior to pickup. Call 760-948-3030 in Victor Valley or 760-256-0311 in Barstow area for pick up reservations from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Sunday.

FARE & PASS USE

Fare must be ready and is due upon boarding. Drivers do not make change. Pennies not accepted. Fare good for single direction trip only. Discount & Student Passes require presentation of photo I.D. when boarding. No refunds or replacements if passes are lost, stolen, damaged, or unused. Passes are not transferable and only valid to person originally issued; use by others is fare evasion, resulting in confiscation, possible prosecution, and fines.

VALUE CARD

The VVTA Value Card is accepted as fare on VVTA buses and available in \$5, \$10, \$20 increments. It is not accepted on VVTA Direct Access ADA service. The VVTA Value Card does not expire, is a great alternative to cash, and a quick way to pay fare without having to fumble around for exact change. For infrequent use, Value Cards are also great as an alternative to carrying cash, especially for students, parents, and seniors. Refunds not available.
